HVCH celebrates successful night of fundraising



The HVCH Foundation raised over \$40,000 gross revenue during its Bids & Brews Benefit held at The Hangar for the first time this year.

Hundreds gathered at the scenic new venue for an evening of laughs, great food, drinks, live music and of course, fundraising.

Traditionally, the auction was part of a larger weekend fundraiser that included a golf tournament held at the Hocking Hills Golf Club. This is the first year the auction has been separated from the golf outing and transformed into its own fundraising event.

"As our auction has continued to grow each year, it was time to think outside of the box for new ideas and opportunities to allow for greater participation," Latricia Johnston, HVCH Chief Public Relations Officer, said.

"Early on, the committee decided to host a golf outing during the middle of

the week to allow for more vendors to enjoy the event without need for working a weekend day to attend. And, when the family of Mr. and Mrs. Roger Shaw graciously offered to donate the use of their large facility for our annual charitable auction, it just all came together," she added. "The new location allowed for the dynamics and ambiance to take on an entirely different style, appealing to an audience of all ages. Thus, the new Bids & Brews Benefit was birthed. The large stage at The Hangar opened up the addition of a concert by Shucking Bubba Deluxe, permitting guests to mingle with friends and dance into the early morning hours."

Over the past 33 years, the auction and golf events have raised nearly \$2 million for charitable purposes at HVCH.

The Bids & Brews benefit featured 80 items in the silent, super silent and live auctions. Food trucks and a beer garden were open throughout the event, and Columbus-area band Shucking Bubba Deluxe performed for the crowd after the live auction. A gun donated by Downs Bait & Guns and a beach vacation donated by the HVCH Board of Trustees also were raffled off.

"I could not be happier with the turnout that we had for our event this past week. The support from the community was overwhelming, and it was great to see so many people in attendance. There are not enough words to express my sincere appreciation to all those who were involved in the planning and preparation for the 2019 HVCH Foundation Auction. We are looking forward to planning for 2020," HVCH President and CEO Stacy Gabriel commented.

"We would like to thank the many people and business who donated auction items," Johnston said. "We could not have this event without their support."

Partners were recognized during the auction and golf events, and will continue to receive recognition throughout the year.
